If you would like something or yourself included, let the Rector know.

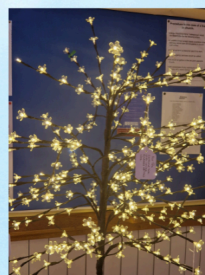
If you would like to be part of the Prayer Group which meets online once a term, also contact the Rector.

150th Anniversary Lecture

We are looking forward to the next in the lecture series when we are delighted to welcome Charles O'Brien FSA. Charles is Listing and Architectural Research Director at Historic England and until 2022 was the joint Series Editor of the Pevsner Architectural Guides, including the Surrey volume. He is a former Commissioner of Historic England and has served as an advisor to government on local heritage.
